


Dear Parents/Carers,

This term we will be continuing learn our numbers bonds of all numbers up to 10, children need to be able to recall all number bonds to 10 quickly without needing to work it out. We will be learning to double and halve numbers, odd and even numbers and spatial reasoning.



Handwriting

This term we are having a big push on handwriting. For your child to meet the Early Learning Goal for writing at the end of the year, they need to be able to form the majority of the letters of the alphabet correctly. We are doing lots of extra hand writing and fine motor work to help strengthen our fingers. We are also going to send home some practice, and would really appreciate if you could support your child at home.
