A volcano is an opening in the Earth's crust that allows magma, hot ash and gases to escape. Make a 'working model' of a volcano and label or explain the key parts.






Option 2:

Create a model of the Solar System


The Solar System includes the Sun, the Earth (where you are now!) and all of the other planets, asteroids and comets that go around and around it
