



Autumn 2 Doves (Y5) Curriculum Newsletter





Dear Parents,

It is lovely to welcome you all back after the half term break. We are looking forward to starting a new half term which we predict will be full of lots of new learning and exciting new units. Here is some information about what we will be learning in the run up to the Christmas break.

Geography:

This term we will be looking in further detail at volcanoes around the world and how they are formed. We will be applying geographical skills such as map reading to find patterns in the locations of volcanoes



around the world. We will then be looking at the impact of volcanoes on humans and find out why people around the world still live in close proximity to them.

DT: Structures - Gingerbread Houses

In DT, we will be creating our very own gingerbread houses!
The project will begin with writing a design brief, where they'll plan out what they want their gingerbread house to look like—thinking about shape, size, and decoration. Once they have their ideas, they'll design their house and create nets and templates to cut out the gingerbread pieces. After baking the pieces from scratch, they'll assemble their houses, using icing as a glue to hold everything together. Finally, they'll decorate their houses with a variety of tasty and creative touches, bringing their designs to life!

Science: The learning within this theme focuses on the Earth and Space. We will learn about the characteristics of the planets and the shape and relative sizes of the Earth, Sun and Moon. In addition to this, we will be describing the movement of the Moon and the Earth in relation to the sun as well as the other planets in the solar system. Finally, we will be using the idea of the Earth's rotation to help us explain day and night and the different moon phases.



PE:

In Outdoor PE this term we will be focusing on developing our knowledge of Tactics & Strategies and applying these to team games. During Indoor PE we will be working on our Speed, Agility & Quickness to continue to develop our Physical Literacy.

RE:

In Religious Education this term we will be working towards answering the question "Why do some people believe in God and some people do not?"



Throughout this unit, we will be learning about the distribution of religions in the world, UK and in Bolton and looking at examples of why people do or do not believe in God. We will use this information to help us to understand how beliefs may impact how people choose to live.

PSHE:

Our topic for PSHE this half term is Relationships. Children will be learning about seeking and giving permission in different situations, recognising



pressure from others and learning where to receive advice and report concerns. At the end of the unit, children will be given the opportunity to discuss and debate topical issues, learning to respectfully agree and disagree.

Computing:

In Computing, we are focusing on Digital Literacy. We will use Purple Mash and Microsoft Excel to create our own databases and graph whilst learning how to use animations and transitions on Microsoft Powerpoint. This will all help us to use technology purposefully to create, organise and store digital content.
