Below is an outline of what we will be learning about during Spring Term.

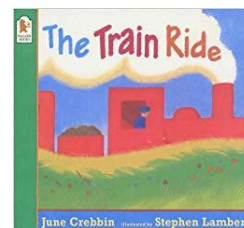
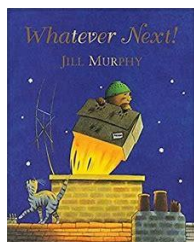
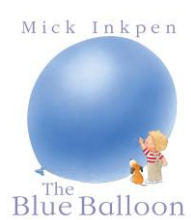
This terms topic overview...

Our topic will be **How will I get there?**

Through this we will be exploring:

- **Land Travel** – cars, trains, diggers, trucks
- **Sea travel** – Boats, submarines, ships
- **Space travel** – rockets, space ships and planets.
- **Air travel** – aeroplanes, hot air balloons, helicopters
- **Chinese New Year** – comparing different celebrations and exploring similarities and differences
- We will also be looking at the season Spring and Winter.

These are some of the books we are going to be learning about linked to our topic:



In addition we will also be reading lots of transport non-fiction books to help us learn new information.

How to help at home...

- Sharing stories
- Singing Nursery Rhymes
- Singing number songs
- Allowing/encouraging independence of self-care tasks such as coats, zips, toileting, handwashing etc
- Providing fun fine motor opportunities such as playing with playdough/ threading/ painting with small brushes or cotton buds/ building with lego (the smaller the better if they're ready!)
- Opportunities to write/ mark make in practical contexts e.g shopping lists.
- Practising next phase of Tricky Words (book marks have been sent home for these)
- Recognising numbers to 20
- Adding and subtracting using objects, then on a numberline, then in our heads counting on and back.
- Practising 2D shapes names and finding corners and sides, children now need to know 3D shape names 'cone, cube, sphere, cylinder' and know the difference between 'solid 3D shapes' and 'flat 2D shapes' e.g discriminating between a triangle and a cone.

Making vehicles

As part of our transport topic we will be making lots of different types of vehicles out of boxes and things for junk modelling. If you have any SMALL boxes, bottle tops or junk (no bigger than a shoebox/ cereal box) that we could use, please either send them into class or keep them at home to use, thank you. We are hoping each child could bring in or save a box in ideally! Thank you!



Reading Challenge

Please make sure you read with your child at least 5 times a week, write in their reading diary and then upload this to Evidence Me before 9am each Friday. Children that have read 5 times will then be in with a chance of winning a book. This includes those children reading at home using Oxford Owl.



Stay and Play

More information to follow, but another virtual Stay and Play will be arranged for Parents/Carers this term that will have a maths focus. This will allow parents to see how we teach Maths in school and provide you with some practical activities and games you can do with your child at home.
