

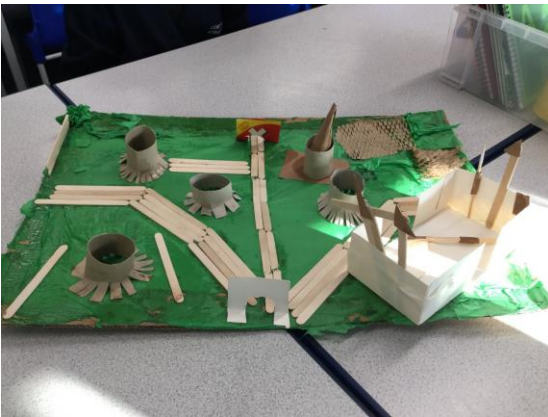

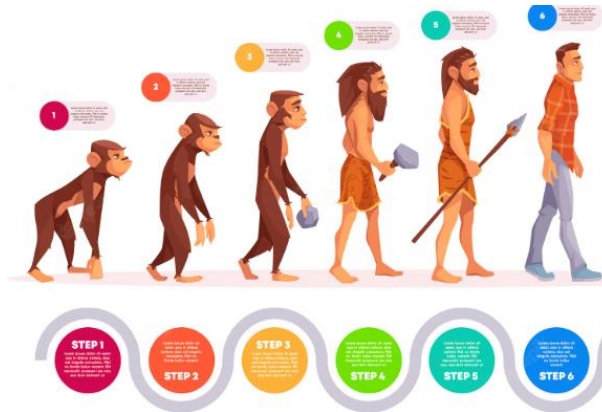
Option 1: Create a model hillfort

Draw or create a detailed Iron Age hill fort. Label the different parts and explain their purposes.



Option 2: Evolution study

Choose an animal species to create an evolution study on. Research its history, evolution and how it is suited to living in its environment. This could be paper based, iMovie, PowerPoint etc... – be creative!



Option 2: Inheritance

Create an 'inheritance family tree' to map features (e.g. eye colour and hair colour) of your family members. See how far back you can trace these characteristics to look for any patterns

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Option 3: Moving animal models (DT – mechanisms)

In DT we will be looking at mechanisms such as levers, pulleys and cams. You could create a moving animal model using resources at home. There are lots of ideas on YouTube under the search "moving animal model mechanisms".
