Option 1: Plant some seeds and observe them growing over time

Try planting some seeds or bulbs in a pot. Some plants take a long time to grow but others, like cress seeds, can grow quite quickly.

Remember to give your seeds or bulbs some water and put them somewhere sunny.

What do you think will happen next?
Post some pictures of your plants growing on seesaw for your teacher to see.



Option 2: Flower art work

Create a picture of a flower.

What colours do you need?

Can you label the different parts of a flower?
(stem, leaves, petals)

Option 3: Flower Pressing

In a spot where you have permission to pick flowers, carefully pick a section from a plant. Try not to damage other flowers or take too many.

Open a book and line it with newspaper.

Place your flowers (as flat as you can) on the page.

Place the flowers you want to press on newspaper between the pages of a book

Carefully close the book and weight it down - additional heavy books work well as weights.

Store this pile in a warm, dry place.

Once your flowers are dry, carefully remove them. You can then create your own flower collection or make some beautiful art.
