
Snack Money...

Independence

A big part of Early Years is to foster children's independence. This can be putting their own coats on, going to the toilet independently, and taking their shoes on and off, washing their hands and using a knife and fork at lunch. We focus on lots of these areas in school and support children in becoming independent. We also ask that these are things you work on with your child at home on a day to day basis.

Please ensure your child brings a coat and school bag each day. Also can you please make sure that everything is labelled with your child's name...even shoes!
