

# **Knowledge Progression in French at Lower Key Stage Two**



## Core: Classroom Commands; Salutations; Colours

- The children will be introduced to the classroom commands which will be used in future lessons.
- An introduction to a selection of typical salutations in French.
- The children will be introduced to colours in French.

### Early: I'm learning French

- Children will learn key facts about France, basic geography of France and the countries that surround it.
- ✓ Children will learn fixed phrases in French to say how they are feeling answering the question ça va? This encourages role play activity with the children
- ✓ The children will learn fixed phrases in French to say what they are called answering the question comment tu t'appelles? This encourages role play activity with the children.
- ✓ The children will learn the numbers from 1 to 10.

### Early: I can

- Recognise some common French verbs/activities.
- Use these verbs to convey meaning in English by matching them to their appropriate picture.
- Use these verbs in the infinitive with je peux...

### **Early: Salutations**

- ✓ Say 'hello' (formally and informally).
- ✓ Say their name.
- ✓ Ask how somebody is feeling and give a reply.
- ✓ Say 'goodbye' and 'see you soon'.

# Early: Colours and Numbers

- ✓ Name and recognise up to ten colours in French.
- ✓ Count from 1-10 in French.

## **Early: Ice-Creams**

- ✓ Name and recognise up to 10 different flavours for ice creams.
- ✓ Ask for an icecream in French using 'je voudrais'.
- ✓ Say what flavour they would like.
- ✓ Say whether they would like their ice-cream in a cone or a small pot/tub.



# **Knowledge Progression in French at Upper Key Stage Two**



### Core: Classroom Commands; Salutations; Numbers

- The children will be introduced to the classroom commands which will be used in future lessons.
- An introduction to a selection of typical salutations in French.
- ✓ Revision of the numbers 1− 10. Should we do 11-20?

## Intermediate: Presenting Myself

- ✓ The children will learn to count to 20 in French.
- They will learn to say their name and age in French.
- The children will say hello and goodbye, ask how somebody is feeling and answer how they are feeling.
- The children will say where they live.
- ✓ They will tell you if they are French or English.
- The concept of gender and agreement will be introduced.

# Intermediate: The Weather

- ✓ The children will learn nine key weather phrases.
- ✓ The main French cities will be introduced through map work.
- Compass points will be introduced in French (dans le nord / dans le sud etc.)
- The children will create and present an authentic weather forecast in French.

## Intermediate: The Family

- ✓ The children will learn the French words for the members of a family.
- ✓ The children will count in 10s to reach 100.
- ✓ The concept of the masculine, feminine and plural versions of my (mon, ma and mes) will be introduced.
- ✓ Introduce the question elle or il s'appelle comment? (what is he or she called?)
- ✓ Introduce the question: As-tu un frère? and As-tu une soeur?

#### Intermediate: At The Cafe

- The children will learn the French words for food and drink items in a cafe.
- ✓ They will learn the French for 'I take', 'I want', 'Thank you' and 'Can I have the bill please?'
- The salutations, 'Hello, goodbye, please and thank you' will be revised.

#### **Intermediate: Clothes**

- ✓ The children will learn to repeat and recognise the vocabulary for a variety of clothes.
- ✓ They will learn to use the appropriate genders and articles for 'a' (un, une) when discussing the clothes.
- The verb PORTER (to wear) and its conjugates will be used with increasing confidence.
- ✓ The children will say what they wear in different weather/situations.
- They will describe the clothes in terms of their colour and apply adjectival agreement. The possessives for my (mon, ma, mes) will be used with increased accuracy.
