AT THE GATES, we believe the curriculum is far greater than just the subjects taught in class. We also believe that it is important for children to pursue their interests beyond lesson time and we aim to provide a wide range of experiences and events to help pupils develop their own interests both within and beyond school. We continue to develop and create a bespoke curriculum, encompassing the statutory guidance of the national curriculum whilst ensuring that our pupils learn what is exciting and relevant.

"The Gates Great Expectations" is unique to The Gates. Throughout each child's journey through our school we intend to provide additional enrichment opportunities alongside the many experiences and opportunities offered on a daily basis throughout our own curriculum.
